- Clean and sanitize exam rooms, treatment areas, kennels, and equipment

- Restock supplies and assist with inventory organization
- Work collaboratively with veterinarians, technicians, and support staff
- Participate in training sessions and team meetings

Qualifications

- Previous experience in a veterinary hospital required
- Certified Veterinary Assistant (CVA) certification is a plus, but not required
- Strong communication skills and a team-oriented mindset
- Willingness to learn, take initiative, and support the hospital mission
- Ability to lift up to 40 lbs

Schedule & Work-Life Balance
