- Ideally, this position will begin a few weeks before the hospital officially opens, in order to help with the final touches of physically setting up the hospital, establishing medical protocols and training new team members.

We anticipate having both exam and surgical teams. Initially, this role may oversee both, with opportunities to grow future leadership structure as the hospital expands.

- Some remote administrative work may be needed during pre-opening onboarding.
